

Admissions and Recruitment

Nova Scotia:

High school applicants must meet the following minimum requirements for admission to the Bachelor of Arts program at St. Thomas University:

- High school graduation (by the end of August of the year in which students apply);
- Minimum average of 70% on five successfully completed Grade 12 academic courses one of which must be English 12 (Academic) or English 12- African Heritage;
- Four remaining academic electives chosen from the list below (please note that, where they exist, AP, IB, Advanced courses and any of the following electives offered in a French Immersion program, are acceptable as substitutes for courses listed below).
