Francophone New Brunswick:

High school applicants from New Brunswick Francophone schools must meet the following minimum requirements for admission to the Bachelor of Arts program at St. Thomas University:

- High school graduation (by the end of August of the year in which they apply);
- Minimum average of **70%** on five successfully completed academic courses one of which must be **Français 10411** (for all applicants from Francophone schools, regardless of their first language);
- Four remaining academic electives chosen from the list below
