

Admissions and Recruitment

Manitoba:

High school applicants from Manitoba must meet the following minimum requirements for admission to the Bachelor of Arts program at St. Thomas University:

- High school graduation (by the end of August of the year in which they apply);
- Minimum average of **70%** on five successfully completed Grade 12 academic courses, one of which must be **English 40S**;
- **Four remaining academic electives** chosen from the list below (please note that, where they exist, AP, IB, enriched courses and any of the following electives offered in a French Immersion program are acceptable as substitutes for courses listed below).
- Applied Math 40S
- Art 40S OR Choral Music 30 Dramatic Arts 40S or Music 40S or Visual Arts 40S
- Biology 40S
- Chemistry 40S
- Chinese 40S
- Cinema as Witness to Modern History 40S
- Current Topics in First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Studies 40S
- Français 40S
- French 40S
