Admissions and Recruitment

British Columbia:

High school applicants from British Columbia must meet the following minimum requirements for admission to the Bachelor of Arts program at St. Thomas University:

- High school graduation (by the end of August of the year in which they apply);
- Minimum average of **70%** on five successfully completed Grade 12 academic courses, one of which must be **English 12** or **English 12 First Peoples**;
- **Four remaining academic electives** chosen from the list below (please note that, where they exist, AP, IB, enriched courses and any of the following electives offered in a French Immersion program are acceptable as substitutes for courses listed below). 12-level, academic Languages will also be considered as admission electives.
