**A: Items That Do Not Require Senate Approval**

- 1. Department of English:** Request to revive ENGL 3433 *World Literature in English: West Indies and Africa* (HMRT) so that the course can be offered in Fall 2015.

Course description: An introduction to the range of literary expressions of writers from the non--Western cultures of the West Indies and Africa. The major genre studied is the novel, though poetry and essays are also examined. The focus of the course is to study the concerns of the colonized, those who were swept up by British expansion in the 18th and 19th centuries. (Post-1800.)
